



Enhancements

RTE

There is a new Image Properties tool inside the RTE that allows you to edit alt text and to resize images to ensure that they are consistently sized and keep their original proportions.




To use this tool, simply click on the image to highlight it and click on the new Alt Text button in the RTE.



Any alt text that is provided will be stored with the image. If it already has alt text, that will automatically be applied.
